RECREATION LEAGUE Grades 2-8 Boys and Girls

The Upper Saddle River Basketball Association will hold in person registration for the 2009-2010 basketball season on Saturday, October 17th and 24th from 9:00am-12:00pm at the USR Borough Hall. Registration is \$125 for the first child \$100 for all other children registered in the 2-8th grade programs (only). Mail in registration is available please refer to the registration form. Deadline for mail in registration is November 6th. Late signups will not be accepted for grades 5-8.

The instructional program for grades 2, 3 and 4 is held on Saturdays beginning December 5th and ending March 20th. The 4th grade program also includes Game time on Sundays. Games will begin in January and end March 21st.

The 5/6th and 7/8th grade programs will have scheduled practice throughout December. Games begin in January and end in March. Games take place Monday through Saturday.

TRAVEL LEAGUE Grades 4-8 Boys and Girls

Travel Tryouts will take place during the week of October 12th. Specific times and gym locations can be found on our web-site.

The registration fee for travel is \$300. This fee includes registration for Travel, Recreation and our in town Basketball Tournament. This fee does not include any uniform expense or additional tournament fees the team may incur. Please do NOT register for recreation until the travel teams have been selected.

HIGH SCHOOL LEAGUE Grades 9-12 Boys

The registration fee is \$125. For registration information see above. To participate in the league you must be a resident of USR, Allendale, HoHoKus, Saddle River or be a student of Northern Highlands High School. Deadline for mail in registration is December 5th. No exceptions will be made for late registrations.
